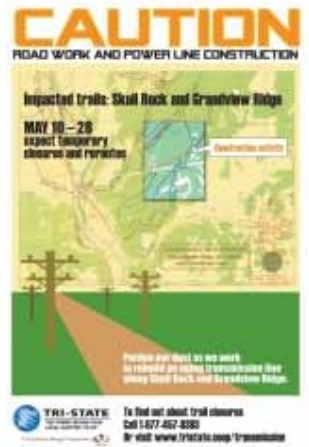


Trailwork this Wednesday, May 13:

When: Wednesday, May 13
Time: 4:00 pm to 7:00 pm
 The hike to the worksite is approximately 35 minute and strenuous. Not all work sites are difficult to get to so please plan accordingly.
Directions: Goeglein Gulch to Skyride Neighborhood. Stay on the main road--Jenkins Ranch. Follow through neighborhood to the end of the road where you'll see the truck parked. Head up the trail towards Raider Ridge. If it is RAINING or SNOWING, trailwork will be canceled. It will be posted at www.trails2000.org on the homepage and on Twitter (@Trails2000) by 2pm on Wednesday.

Tri State Transmission Work

Durango, Colo. - Tri-State Generation and Transmission (G&T), the power supplier to La Plata Electric Association, will be performing additional earth work activities along the Grandview Ridge and Cowboy trails from May 10 - 28 to finalize the reconstruction of the Bayfield-Durango 115-kilovolt transmission line. The work, expected to be completed by month's end, will address additional contouring and re-vegetation activities along the project's corridor and access routes. Construction crews will need to temporarily close portions of Cowboy trail for the public's safety, so please keep a look out for informational signage, traffic control personnel, and heavy equipment along the trail.

Fuels Project on Animas Mountain

The public will have the opportunity to learn about the most recent proposal for the Animas City Mountain Fuels Reduction Project at an open house on Thursday, May 13, 2010 at the Durango Recreation Center. San Juan Public Lands staff will be on hand to offer information and answer questions from 4:30 to 8 p.m.

The Columbine Ranger District/Field Office has released for public review a revised Draft Environmental Assessment (EA) for hazardous fuels mitigation on Animas City Mountain. The new proposal calls for alternative means of access and implementation to accomplish fuels reduction on 1900 acres of BLM lands on top of and on the western flanks of Animas City Mountain.
